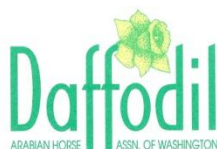

Riders who choose not to wear a protective helmet do so at their own risk. All riders must wear a boot with a heel.

**Daffodil Arabian Horse Association invites you to participate in this clinic and schooling show.**

**Clinics will be held on Saturday, March 13, with the schooling show to follow on Sunday, March 14. Both are open to all horse enthusiasts. All proceeds will benefit the Daffodil Youth Programs. Clinicians are professional trainers and/or qualified individuals from the Horse industry within the Northwest. This event promises to be fun, educational and a great way to begin getting your horses ready for the upcoming show season. We hope to see you!**

**CLINICS:** Enter one or two clinics by checking your choices. Third session may be paid for the day of the clinics, if available. Sessions will be run with two to four riders per session. Sessions will be approximately one hour in length. You will be notified of your session time via e-mail, US mail or phone call several days in advance. Clinics are Western Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure, English Pleasure, Equitation, Halter, Trail, Sport Horse in Hand and Under Saddle.

**GOLD DOLLARS SCHOOLING SHOW:** Gold Dollars and Flat ribbons in all classes from 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> place. No entry fee for championship classes. They are open to horses placing 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in qualifying classes; for example, walk/trot hunter pleasure championship is open to all those placing 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in any walk/trot hunter pleasure class.

Rosette ribbons to five places in Championship classes, with great horse luggage for the champion. **FIFTY GOLD DOLLARS** for High Point Youth and High Point Amateur will be awarded at the end of the show.

**STABLING INFORMATION:** Stabling is available beginning 8:00 am, March 13 and must be vacated by 6 pm Sunday, March 14. Those waiting to come on Sunday may arrive by 7:00 a.m. We will provide 1 bale of shavings per stall; additional bales will be available for purchase @ the office for \$7.00 per bale.

**JUDGING CLINIC:** Learn about judging horses and prepare for horse judging contests. A classroom session will begin on Saturday at 10:30 am at the show office. Live judging will follow. You must be present at both sessions. No charge for this clinic but you must sign up by return of entry form.

**CLASS RULES:** No stopping/backing on the rail. Must attempt to follow class calls. Commonly accepted schooling equipment allowed. Show clothes are not required. Boots with a heel are required. Protective helmets strongly advised. Extended gaits may be called for in senior horse and open classes at the discretion of judge.
